
# How to register on the I2E learning portal?

Step 1 - go on www.ecqa.org/Learning Portal/Register




Step 2 - enter your username and password/login

Step 1 - go on www.ecqa.org/Learning Portal/Register




#### Step 2 - select your profession/Next






Step 3 - select your training organisation/Next (make sure to register as EMIRAcle)




# If you are new:

## After registering to the system:


Next Step - select your assessment



You are logged in automatically. Once logged in you can browse the skill card and perform a self-assessment or connect to the learning management system.


#### Perform Self-Assessment:



### Connect to the learning management system:






### Attend courses online:


After the user selects Sign In from the Learning Steps function, the Moodle System is opened in a new window. The user is enrolled to the selected course.
